

# Favours for a Baby Shower



Giving favours for the guests at your Baby shower is a lovely way to say thank you for coming and to show your appreciation for your friends' gifts and help.

For Rebecca's Baby Shower, we made these cute nappy-shaped favours that each hold a tin of lip balm for all of the girls.



## To make nappy shaped favours:

- Find some fabric to suit your “nappy” design. We chose a plain lining material to give the appearance of white nappies but you could choose bright colours or gingham
- Draw a template that is roughly airplane-shaped as above. It needs to be big enough to enclose the gift you’ve chosen. We chose the little tin range of lip-balms available from Superdrug
- Cut 2 nappy shapes from your template for each favour. Cut a third from stiffening – this could be a thick serviette or interfacing fabric
- Sew the three layers of nappy shapes together with the stiffening on the inside. You can use zig-zag or overlocking stitching all the way around the nappy
- Stitch or glue the nappy together at the front around your gift
- Draw a nappy pin design on one of the “wings” of the nappy – or use little gold mini-safety pin to finish the favours.
